Winemaking: Handpicked in early March - coinciding with my birthday - the fruit was carefully destemmed and fermented as whole berries in an open fermenter. The fermenter was sealed and inertly gassed for four days to encourage carbonic maceration, fostering vibrant, fruity aromas. Once fermentation became active, the cap was gently plunged to ensure minimal tannin extraction, preserving the wine's elegant structure. The wine was pressed off early and transferred to stainless steel to complete fermentation, followed by an early bottling to capture and showcase its lively, juicy berry character.

Tasting Note: Juicy red and purple berry fruits burst through on the palate, complemented by subtle hints of cinnamon and nutmeg. Bright and fresh, with soft, chalky tannins lending structure and finesse. Enjoy slightly chilled for maximum refreshment.

This wine doesn't know if it's "Arthur or Martha"! Delicious slightly chilled, yet with enough tannin to shine at room temperature.
